

**Paradise Town Council Meeting**

**Minutes**

Bev read the minutes of April 1st. A motion was made by Margaret to approve the minutes. Seconded by Dale. All in favor.

**Deputy Ramirez report**

Deputy Ramirez reported that he had given tickets at the 4 way stop, on the south side of town, for citizens going 20 over the speed limit. The Mayor told him not to be lenient with the offenders, to give tickets to those 10 and over. Lee also reported that the council will work on looking at ordinances regarding ATV's and noise ordinances.

**Fire Department Report**

Troy asked the council if they have thought of locations for the new fire station. There was an extensive discussion on the process of getting the location and funds to build. Lee wants Troy to bring in plans that the council can look at.

**Bills**

Margaret read the bills. A motion was made by Mat to accept the bills as read. Seconded by Margaret. All in favor.

**Adopt NIMS**

A motion was made by Margaret to approve the NIMS - Emergency Operation Plan as reviewed and revised at our April 1st meeting. Seconded by Dale. All in favor. Bev will have 7 copies printed and file the disc.

**Council Reports**

- **Roads** – Margaret is still waiting for bids on the pot holes. Lee reported that Martel Lowe had called him regarding the potholes. He fills potholes for Hyrum City. His plan was to fill the potholes with cold mix. Lee suggested that if the bids come in high, we might want to consider Martel's offer. The work on the bridge is underway.

- **Water** – The cut off date for delinquent bills is Saturday, May 2<sup>nd</sup>. Bev will give Lee a list by then.
- **Community** –
  1. Dairy Princess Pageant – Mat called the recommended contacts and didn't get any further information.
  2. Farmers Market Report – Mat & Dale reported on the April 6<sup>th</sup> meeting. There was an extensive discussion on the pros and cons of having a farmers market. Mat & Dale will be attending the next planning meeting on April 20<sup>th</sup>.
  3. The ladies from the DUP want to tile the kitchen. Lee suggested that we just take the money that they would have spent on the project and we have someone else do it. That way we can upgrade the tile to a commercial grade like we did the carpet.
  4. Kennel Licensing – Bev will write Justin Wilding regarding his dog tags and kennel licensing. Bev gave John a list of kennel applicants. He is going to visit each kennel to see if they are in compliance.

#### **New Business**

Bev will get with Lee regarding the payroll audit for the Trust.

#### **Unfinished Business**

- Lee will talk to Jeff Covert regarding cleaning up the Car Service. Dale said that there are others in town that aren't in compliance with the junk ordinance. Margaret suggested sending a letter to those that aren't in compliance.
- Mat made a suggestion to the council that they start recruiting people to run for council.
