Minutes

Bev read the minutes of July 15, 2009. A motion was made by Leland to approve the minutes. Seconded by Margaret. All in favor.

Bills

Building Permit – Dale Anderson – 70 East 9300 South – Shed

Review Noise Ordinances

John Stark, a member of the P&Z commission, came to address the changes made in the proposed noise ordinance. There was an extensive discussion regarding the different changes. Lee will call Ed Durrant and see if he can come to our meeting with a decibel meter. The Council & Commission would like to go out and measure different sounds around the Town.

Fire Department Report

Blake came in to make sure the dates for the building and pavilion were reserved for Trout & Berry Day. He also reported on the fire department's new purchases.

Council Reports

- **Roads** – The bid came in from Consolidated to slurry seal 10 blocks. The bid came in at \$66,000.00, which seemed high. The Town will get additional bids. Lee called Hyrum Irrigation to see if they could shut off the irrigation water for the canal project on 8800 S 220 W. They probably would approve the shut off the middle of September. It might be best to wait until the end of September. Parsons' & Johnson's wouldn't be able to come out until then. A motion was made by Margaret for Lee to call and talk with Johnson's and Parsons' and give the bid to the company that meets our needs. Seconded by Dale. All in favor.

- **Water** – The council went over the delinquent water list. Bev will call Lee and confirm if Marla kept her commitment to pay.
- **Community** – Mat updated the website and wondered if the council wanted the approved minutes on the website. Lee wondered if we should have a time limit on how long we have them available. He also reported that Rocky Mountain Power would not allow the Farmer’s Market to hang a sign from their poles.

New Business

- Future Eagle Projects were discussed.
- The weeds around the Town sign need to be treated.
- The playground needs to be tilled.
