Minutes

Bev read the minutes of October 21, 2009. A motion was made by Dale to approve the minutes. Seconded by Mat. All in favor.

Bills

Margaret read the bills as corrected. A motion was made by Mat to accept the bills as read. Seconded by Margaret. All in favor.

Building Permit for Lyle Henriod – 9190 S 200 E – Addition to Barn

The Council went over the permit for an addition to Lyle Henriod's barn. All looked in order. A motion was made by Dale to approve the permit. Seconded by Margaret. All in favor.

Report from Department of Environmental Response and Remediation

Bill Rees from the Department of Environmental Quality came to talk to the Council regarding Brownfield's and the tools and resources related to it. He gave an overview of what his agency can do to assist in identifying and cleaning up a Brownfield.

Noise Ordinance

John Stark went over the proposed changes with the Council. The Planning and Zoning Commission met after the Public Hearing held on September 29, 2009 and made changes to the noise ordinance as suggested by the public in attendance. The Council suggested other changes to be made. John will take those proposals to the Planning and Zoning.

Report from Fire Department

Blake brought over a check request for clay pigeons for the Trap Shoot over the Thanksgiving weekend.

Council Reports

- **Roads** – Lee had Nick Jones of Utah LTAP look at the intersection at 9200 S 200 W. He suggested that because the intersection is blind on all sides, a 4 way stop sign should be put up. Margaret made a motion that the Town adds 2 more stop signs making the intersection a 4 way stop. She suggested that we cover the signs with black garbage bags over them for 2 weeks. Seconded by Mat. All in favor.
- **Water** – Intermountain Environmental is giving us a bid on a telemetry system for the well at the park. Lee reported that the new well needs a new meter. Margaret made a motion to purchase a water meter for the Hyrum Canyon Well. Seconded by Mat. All in favor.
- **Community** – The Council will be attending the Envision Utah presentation on November 17th at Bridgerland.

Unfinished Business

Guy Wuetherich came in to request an extension in moving his hay stall. He would like to move it by April 1st. The Council didn't think there was a problem with his proposal. Bev will get a contract for Guy to sign.
