Oath of Office

Bev swore in Mayor Leland Howlett, Jay Rinderknecht and Kyle Smith.

Bills

Mat read the bills. A motion was made by Kyle to accept the bills as read. Seconded by Jay. All in favor.

Review and consider job for Public Works/Development Director

The Council went over the job description for the Public Works/Development Director position. It was determined that this would be a part-time job. A motion was made by Jay to approve the job description. (Included in these minutes) Seconded by Mat. All in favor. It was discussed that an hourly wage would be between \$15.00 to \$20.00. A motion was made by Kyle to approve the salary range. Seconded by Jay. All in favor.

Fire Department

Blake reported to the Council that Wal-mart/South donated to the department \$2,500.00. It was unexpected and much appreciated.

Troy inquired about Brandon Pulsipher's claim. Bev told Troy that she would call and talk to Mindi in the morning.

Council Reports

Leland made assignments to the Council. He assigned Jay to Roads, Kyle to Water and Mat to Community. Don's assignment will be made at the next Town Council Meeting.

- **Roads** – Jay wanted to know about the arrangement to fix the road by Wayne Norman's house. No one on the Council knew of it. It was decided to invite the Normans to a Council meeting. The Town received an email from Chad Magnum regarding plowing the block and 1/2. Leland said that he would respond to his email, explaining to him that until the developer finishes his work on the road, it can not be dedicated to the Town.

- **Water** – Bev will remind Lee to bring in a door hanger so that she could have them copied.
- **Community** – Mat talked to Clay Robinson, the vet, regarding the upcoming Dog Clinic. Clay will get back with Mat regarding the dates. It will be either February 20th or 27th.

New Business

- Paul Willardson, from J-U-B Engineers introduced himself to the Council and offered his services if needed.
- Kyle brought up the “suggestion box” which was mentioned at “Meet the Candidates” night. Bev suggested that she put something on the bottom of the water bill this month.
