Minutes

Fire Department

Leland told Troy that the Jeep sold. The money will be put back in the department's capital improvement fund. The Council went over the May 2nd Emergency Preparedness

Plan. Troy suggested that CERT (Citizens Emergency Response Training) be offered at the Emergency Meeting to see if there were anyone that is interested. There was an extensive discussion between the Department and the Council regarding Emergency protocol.

Council Reports

- **Roads** – Jay filled out the interlocal agreement with the County for the grading of roads. Consolidated has already come out to fill potholes. There are still other potholes that need attention. Jay recommended that we meet with Zane Murray of JUV Engineering to see if he could come and make a proposal to see how we can retrieve tax dollars for roads in our town.
- **Water** – Kyle, Mat and Leland met with Environmental Engineering to get a quote for the telemetry. Leland proposed that at a future meeting discuss fencing around the water tank for source protection security. Bev will tell Lee to go and talk with Craig Dart regarding his overage.
- **Community** – Mat reminded everyone of the League Conference in September. He also wanted to know if it would be helpful to have a container for old household batteries. He will talk to the people at the landfill to inquire if there are already containers. The Emergency Preparation meeting is scheduled for Sunday, May 2nd at 4:00 at the new church. Mat also suggested that we hold a mock disaster at some time in the future.
- **Grants/Fire/Budget** – Nothing to report at this time.
