

Introduction: Purpose

- Emergency Operations Plan (EOP) is intended to serve as a guideline for response to major disasters or emergencies in the town of Paradise and surrounding areas.
- It is understood that **a written plan cannot replace the common sense and good judgment** necessary for effective response to emergency conditions.
- The purpose of this plan is to outline emergency operations that are intended to:
 - Eliminate or reduce the chance of occurrence and the effects of an emergency or disaster
 - Identify what preparations are needed and to what extent
 - Determine how to respond when an emergency or disaster occurs
 - Promote recovery and restoration of the community
- The most important priority in emergency response is to **protect and preserve human life.**

Unless the disaster is isolated to just our area, it is highly unlikely that we will receive significant outside help ...


... we must be prepared to take care of ourselves for an extended period of time.

Operational Phases


1. Preparation/Mitigation
 - CERT (Community Emergency Response Team)
 - Ward preparation
 - **Individual/Family preparation**
2. Response
 - Awareness
 - Activation
 - Emergency Operations Team (EOT)
 - Emergency Operations Center (EOC)
 - Assessment
 - Public Needs
 - Individual Needs
3. Recovery
 - Short-term
 - Long-term

Emergency Operations Team


• Block Captains need to identify and communicate:

- Needs

- Rescue
- Medical
- Food/Water
- Shelter

- Available Resources

- Medical Personnel
- Able people
- Equipment
- Supplies



- Individual families should use red/green ribbons
- Wards may communicate via handheld (FRS/GMRS) radio
 - Use channel corresponding to ward number


