Minutes

Public Hearing

• **Amend Budget 2009-2010**

Mayor Howlett went over the amended 2009-2010 budget. A motion was made by Kyle to approve the amended budget for 2009-2010. Seconded by Jay. All in favor.

• **Adopt Budget 2010-2011**

Mayor Howlett went over the budget for 2010-2011. Leland answered questions regarding the cemetery district and other projected expenditures. A motion was made by Jay to adopt the 2010-2011 budgets. Seconded by Kyle. All in favor.

Park Discussion

Paul Danielson and his realtor Bruce Leishman discussed different properties that might be suitable for the Town's proposed park.

Council Reports

- **Roads** – Leland suggested that we spray the weeds growing up through the asphalt. It would certainly help preserve the road. The Council thought it was a good idea.
- **Water** – Kyle reported that the fence is repaired up by the spring. Custom Fence has started putting in the fence by the reservoir. Leland and Lee will replace the lid on the water tank this week. Kyle is finishing up his water rate survey and will be able to discuss it at our next meeting. Leland asked Mat to call Mike Lusk at Intermountain Environmental regarding a bid on new telemetry.

- **Community** – Mat will take the soccer nets off.
- **Grants/Fire/Budget** – Don reported that he needs more specific information before he can inquire further with Ruby Pipeline. He gave the Council information regarding Community Development Block Grants.

Unfinished Business

- Leland reported that Justin Wilding wanted to know what was happening with his subdivision. Mayor Howlett will compile a letter for Justin explaining that when the improvements are done he will have a settlement conference with him.
- Leland is waiting for the final settlement form from the Leishman’s attorney.
