Minutes

Eagle Project Report

Colton Wuetherich reported on his Eagle Project. He and Matt Forbes have replaced the drinking fountain at the North Park. Standard Plumbing donated the plumbing supplies and Dave Anderson donated the brick. Mayor Howlett signed Colton's paper work and will sign Matt's upon completion of the project.

Fire Department – Troy inquired about Taylor Heaton's Eagle project to paint the fire hydrants. The project has been shelved until the spring. Mayor Howlett will call Taylor and advise him to wait until the spring. Blake turned in an invoice for the Trap Shoot shot gun. Blake also turned in check requests for the department's officer compensation.

Council Reports

- **Roads** – Trudy Bremer complained about kids riding horses on the town right a way. Kyle fixed the stop sign by Craig Dart. He reported that Clark Gibbs wants a 4 way stop on the intersection at 300 West and 8700 South. Jay will contact ULTAP and request a survey. There was an extensive discussion on snow removal procedures.
- **Water** – Mayor Howlett and Lee fixed the problems up the canyon with the broken valves. They will submit the bill to the County. Mayor Howlett reported on the water meters that need to be replaced because of leaks.

- **Community** – Mat scheduled the putting up of the Christmas lights for December 7th at 9am. Mat has also scheduled training with the ULD. They said that they would come and train us. Mat will check to see if they can come on December 1st and hour before our regularly scheduled Town Council Meeting. The park committee meeting will be tomorrow the 18th at 7:00 pm. Don is checking with USU to see if there are any students needing a project. He hasn't heard back as of yet.
- **Grants/Fire/Budget** – Nothing to report at this time.
