Minutes

A motion was made by Jay to approve the amended minutes of June 1, 2011. Seconded by Mat. All in favor.

Bills

Fire Department

- Troy reported that the department had applied for a Forestry grant (\$4,000), AFG grant (5% match on \$50,000) and the Safer grant (recruit and retention). As far as recruiting, Troy would like to see more volunteers that could be here during the day. (ie. Stay at home moms or farmers)
- They turned in their vehicle inspection information.
- Troy briefly discussed the upcoming Emergency Fair.

Council Reports

- **Roads** – LeGrand Johnson's will be coming Friday (17th) or Monday (18th) to work on the road. Jay will call them and tell Johnson's to wait until Monday so we have time to mark our valves.

- **Water** – Mayor Howlett reported that we need to decide what type of water meters we want to purchase. If we go over the \$20,000 mark we will need to put it out for bid. He has quotes from Neptune and Masters. He also suggested that when we get the meters we start reading monthly, so we can let customers know more immediately when they have a leak.
- **Community** – Audra Jackson will be driving the Town float in the Hyrum parade. Mat will ask her to purchase the candy for the float. Mat asked about the soccer goals and when they should be put away. He will talk to Brooke Hansen.
- **Grants/Fire/Budget** – Nothing to report at this time.

- Jason Summers from the Park Committee had an extensive discussion with the Council to discuss park alternatives.
