Minutes

A motion was made by Don to approve the minutes of September 7, 2011 as amended. Seconded by Mat. All in favor.

Bills

Don read the bills of September 21, 2011. A motion was made by Jay to accept the bills as read. Seconded by Don.

Council Reports

- **Roads** – Mayor Howlett asked Jay to call Johnson’s regarding their bill. (We haven’t yet received it.)
- **Water** - Mayor Howlett reported that the spring is still providing for water needs. He also reported that the discharge pipe at the park well had corroded and needs to be replaced.
- **Community-** Mat reported that Peggy Nath was starting another CERT class starting tomorrow, September 22nd. Mayor Howlett reported that Nathan Peel wanted to replace the swings on the playground for his Eagle project. Mayor Howlett told him that the Town could allocate \$1,000.00 for the project. Currently the swings at the park are grandfathered. When the swings are replaced they will have to be up to playground safety code.
- **Grants/Fire/Budget** – Don brought in a bid for the delineators.

Unfinished Business - Mayor Howlett reported that the Town truck needs to have some repairs and new tires before the snow falls.

New Park Discussion – Mat called the County regarding their help with the grading of the new park. He was told that they were busy and couldn’t do it. He talked to Lynn Zollinger of the County road department, regarding the second entrance to the south at the park. Mr. Zollinger said it would be OK if we go 60 feet to the north from the opposite driveway. This will eliminate the overlapping left turns. Mat forwarded this

report to Jason, Kyle and Mayor Howlett. Mr. Zollinger will need to have a to-scale drawing of the driveway placements. After we turn in the plat for the driveway, we can get final approval.

A motion was made by Jay to adjourn. Seconded by Don. All in favor. Meeting closes at 8:07 pm.
