Minutes- The minutes of March 21, 2018 and April 4, 2018 were emailed to the Council members previous to the meeting. Vic made a motion to approve the minutes of March 21, 2018; Martell seconded that motion, all in favor. Shannon made a motion to approve the minutes of April 4, 2018; Vic seconded that motion, all in favor.

Bills- Martell read the bills. There was discussion on a few bills and what they were for. Vic made a motion to approve the bills as read; Martell seconded that motion, all in favor.

Public Comment- None at this time.

Department Expenditures-

Discussion on bleacher purchase- An updated quote was received from Great Western for the ADA-compliant bleachers for approximately \$22,500.00. There was also a quote received from Garrett and Company for smaller bleachers like we have at the town square park now. The quote from Garrett and Company for the smaller bleachers totaled 13,000.00. The ADA bleachers sit 64 people, and each of the smaller bleachers can sit 50 people, the quote is for 4 of the bleachers, so approximately 200 people. The Council discussed if it may be better to pour a cement pad to sit the bleachers on that could also accommodate a walkway and wheelchairs.

One-quarter cent Sales Tax Cache County Increase Discussion- There was a discussion on whether the Council would support this small increase on Cache County sales tax. Mayor Atwood received an email detailing what the small towns and cities would receive yearly from this increase. Mayor Atwood will gather information and get some clarification on exactly how this increase would affect Paradise citizens if the Town Council did or did not support the increase, and if the increase will still take place even if not supported by every Town and City in the County.

Council Reports

- **Roads- Martell Lowe-** Martell is going to get some paint to mark the potholes that need to be patched. Morgan will be coming to patch those potholes ASAP. Martell tried to hook the mower up to his tractor, but could not get it hooked up. He is going to check hydraulics, and will see if there is anything else he needs to look at.

- **Water- Vic Little-** Nothing at this time.
- **Community-Shannon Rasmussen-** Shannon met with the Youth Council last night. They planned an activity for May 22, at 5:00 p.m. to weed around the Town Sign. Mayor Atwood would like to get the logs fixed on the sign this year and then replace some of the shrubs, bark, etc. He suggested Shannon have the kids weed in quadrants and maybe spray some of the bad weeds before Memorial Day. The President of the Youth Council is Mackenzie Atwood, Vice President is Madeline Weaver, and Secretary is Emma Sharp. They have also planned an activity for the older kids on the last day of school June 1, 2018. They would like to host night games at the North Park and have a bonfire.
- **Fire/Grants/Budget-Spencer Winn-** Fire Chief Troy Fredrickson got a bid from RC Welding for a railing on the ramp out front of the Fire Department. The bid came in at approximately \$1,687.50. This would be for a 28.12 f.t., metal, powder-coated railing. They are about 3 weeks out before they could complete the work. There is a hydrant that needs to be fixed at approximately 9100 S. and 300 W. Mayor Atwood acknowledged he was aware of the issue and will get it fixed.

Unfinished Business-

Tyson Sharp Eagle Scout Project- Vic talked to Tyson and he reported that there would only be one post that may need to be set in concrete. There was discussion on the placement of the sign.

Dogs running at large- There was a discussion on dogs running at large. Residents are encouraged to call animal control when there are any issues with dogs running at large.

Non-conforming Buildings- There was a discussion on some non-conforming buildings that need to come down.

New Business-

No new business at this time.

Adjourn- Vic made a motion to adjourn at 9:58 p.m., Martell seconded that motion, all in favor.
