

Paradise Town Council
April 15, 2020
7:30 p.m.

Meeting was held electronically using Zoom. All Council members were present electronically.

Council Members Present- Mayor Vic Little, Larry Johnson, Shannon Rasmussen, Jason Winn, Alyssa Petersen (Recorder)

Excused- Trent Passey

Minutes- The Minutes of April 1, 2020 were emailed to all Council Members prior to the meeting. Shannon made a motion to accept the Minutes of April 1, 2020 as written, Jason seconded that motion, all in favor.

Bills- The bill list was emailed to Council members prior to the meeting. Larry read the bills. Jason made a motion to approve the checks for April 15, 2020, Larry seconded that motion, all in favor.

Council Reports-

- **Roads- Trent Passey-** Trent is excused from the meeting.
- **Water- Larry Johnson-** Larry reported that the waterline down the highway is installed and tested for bacteria. The test was negative for any bacteria. The plan is to let the line settle until next year, and then complete the loop in the water line. Larry has been finding and adding GPS coordinates on a map of all the water valves around Town so that we have an accurate location for the valves and lines around Town.
- **Community- Shannon Rasmussen-** Shannon has attempted to contact the Youth Council about different projects. She wondered about getting the dumpster here for a few weeks beginning on Monday April 20. The Council had considered using the Youth Council to help man the dumpster in the past, but there was concern about using the Youth Council now during a “stay home, stay safe” directive from the Utah State Governor.
- **Fire/Grants/Budget- Jason Winn-** Jason wondered if Mayor Little was able to find a price on weather-guard boxes for the bed of the new brush truck. Jason reported that they are using the current bids they have submitted for lighting and outfitting the truck. Mayor Little will get the bid for the boxes.

Fire Department Brush Truck- The Fire Department has picked up their new brush truck. They are now working on getting it fitted with toolboxes, lights, etc. The Fire Department would like to start working on getting the lights and signage on the truck Monday April 20, 2020. The bid for the lights and graphics was \$7,545.00. Mayor Little talked with the Fire Department about what could be removed from the old truck and moved to the new truck. There was discussion

on what to do with the old brush truck and if the Town should use that truck as a Town truck now. Larry made a motion to approve spending the \$7,545.00 on lights and graphics on the new brush truck 90, Jason seconded that motion, all in favor.

Unfinished Business-

Mayor Little has talked with 4/5 people that are interested in serving on the Planning and Zoning Commission. The Council would like to hold a meeting to appoint the 3 people needed to have a complete commission.

Mayor Little reported that there is some cut wood laying around Town that people can take until its gone.

Mayor Little asked if there has been an updated contract sent by the County yet? Jason reported that it will come in the mail so to watch for it.

Jason reported that he had a few concerns regarding the sign base for the stop signs that need to go in at 9200 S. and 300 E. The base is poured and sticking out the ground and waiting for the stop sign to be put in.

New Business- No new business at this time.

Adjourn- Larry made a motion to adjourn, Shannon seconded that motion, all in favor, meeting adjourns at 8:07 p.m.
