Water Meter Reading

Some have asked who the young man is, he wears a safety vest and carries a stick with a tennis ball on the end. That's Kyle, he's reading our water meters this time around.

Roughly every 6 months we have a willing soul read the water meters. The town allots each customer 10,000 gallons a month, if your usage reflects more than 70,000 gal in 7 months one of the following issues may exist.

- Lawn or yard watering with culinary water
- Excessive Livestock watering or broken automatic watering system
- A Leak between the meter and the residence. (If a leak is identified and repaired by the property owner the Town will reduce the overage charge by 50%)

If none of these items identify the overage, please call Town Hall so we can help find a solution.

Additional information on restrictions for Cross Connection Hookups and Potable Water Sprinkler systems can be found under town ordinance numbers 14-110.1 and 14-133.1.
