Minutes - The Minutes of July 15, 2020 were not emailed to the Council members previous to the meeting, the minutes were tabled until next meeting.

Bills- Trent read the bills. Jason made a motion to accept the bills as read, Larry seconded that motion. All in favor.

Public Comment- No public comment at this time.

Planning and Zoning

- **Rusty and Tammy Stott- New Home- 255 W. 8600 S.-** The Council discussed need for driveway to go in for construction access. There was discussion on water shares and the need to transfer shares before occupancy permit can be issued. Shannon made a motion to approve the application, Jason seconded that motion. Larry is opposed.
- **Chad and Cassidy Bradshaw- Shed- 210 E. 9000 S.-** The Council went over the application. Jason made a motion to approve the application for the shed, Trent seconded that motion. All in favor.

Mandi Felici- Trout and Berry Days Update- Mandi attended the meeting and gave an update on Trout and Berry Days. There was discussion on Trout and Berry Days T-Shirts and T-shirts for the Youth Council. Mayor Little gave an update on the rodeo and the parade. There was discussion on a royalty contest and discussion on dinner.

Unfinished Business- Jason wondered if playground equipment had been ordered. Mayor Little requested that the meeting be held at the Park so that the potential playground could be laid-out and then order the equipment.

Mayor Little reported on the Court date with the non-compliant property owners. The court date went differently than the Mayor was anticipating. The Court date was set back another month and will be addressed the end of August.

Mayor Little reported that the Fire Department overhead door will be approximately \$1,300.00 to get fixed.

Mayor Little reported that the two squads were sold for \$4000.00, \$2,000.00 per piece.

New Business- No new business at this time.

Council Reports

- **Roads-Trent Passey** – Trent submitted a map with some suggestions for slurry seal work around Town. Lee had suggested to Trent some of the roads that need to be done. Trent submitted an estimate from Morgan Paving along with the map. There was discussion on if the Slurry Seal should be done this year. There was discussion on how much was in the Road Account that could be put towards this project. The Council decided to table this decision until funds could be verified.
- **Water-Larry Johnson-** Larry updated the Council on the vault and air-release work. There was discussion on the water fund and the road fund.
- **Community- Shannon Rasmussen-** Shannon would like to order shirts for the Youth Council. She talked with the Logo Shop as they had the design on file. She would like to have the shirts by Trout and Berry Days. She will get a quote from the Logo Shop. The Youth Council would need 10 shirts. The Mayor had a request for an Eagle Scout project at the Sign.
- **Fire/Grants/Budget- Jason Winn-** Jason reported that the Fire Department had been awarded an \$8000.00 Forestry Grant that will cover the \$5000.00 radios they would like to purchase for the new truck. Jason reported on the Fires the Fire Department was on recently. Jason wondered if funds had been received from the CARES act for Fire and EMS Personnel in the State of Utah. We have not received anything at this time. Mayor Little suggested Jason talk with Chief about if there was anything additional needed to receive the CARES funds.
